

# HTML / Front Page Vocabulary

**Editor:** A program that creates files or makes changes to existing files. In FrontPage, Page view is a Web page editor, and the HTML tab in Page view is an HTML editor.

**Home page:** On the World Wide Web, an entry page for a set of Web pages and other files in a Web site, some Web servers use Index.htm as the name.

**HTML:** Hypertext Markup Language. The standard language used for documents on the World Wide Web. It uses tags to indicate how Web browsers should display page elements such as text and graphics, and how Web browsers should respond to user actions such as hyperlinks.

**HTTP:** (Hypertext Transfer Protocol) The Internet protocol that enables Web browsers to retrieve information from World Wide Web servers

**Hyperlinks** Text or graphics that have information embedded that permit the user to jump between information. These items are the primary means of navigation on and among web sites.

**Page:** A single document in a Web site written in HTML.

**Page view:** The view in FrontPage you use for creating, editing, and previewing Web pages. This view displays web pages as they will appear in a Web browser.

**Parent page:** In FrontPage, a page in a web that is part of the navigation structure of the web and is linked to one or more pages on the child level. A page on the child level is accessed from by following a link from a navigation bar on the parent page.

**Theme:** This component applies professionally designed graphics that consist of similar design elements and color schemes for bullets, fonts, graphics, and other page elements. When applied, it gives pages a consistent appearance.

**URL:** Uniform Resource Locator. A string that supplies the Internet address of a Web site or resource on the World Wide Web, along with the protocol by which the site or resource is accessed. The most common URL type is http://, which gives the Internet address of a Web page.

**Web:** A home page and its associated pages, graphics, documents, multimedia, and other files created in FrontPage and stored on a Web server or on a computer's hard drive.

**Web browser:** Software that interprets the markup of files in HTML, formats them into Web pages, and displays them to the user.
